The Battleplan

Shepherding a Nation of Builders or ‘GK Builders Track’

- a. Explain need for pastoring to go alongside operations. For every **operational** training component there will be a corresponding **pastoral** component.
 - b. Introduce **GK BUILDERS TRACK**. CLP style talks / outlines / manuals that are comprehensive and easily replicable which every GK volunteer will go through.
 - c. Talk about format, talks and how it should be conducted (mission team from outside the branch to go there, etc)
 - d. Distribute talk outlines to all participants

 - iii. Establish at least one A-team and a 1MB Coordinator as minimum
 - iv. Hold GK Builder's Track
 - v. Continue with further training and monthly assemblies
 - vi. How to upgrade your mission team (adding more roles, e.g. Build coordinator, Heroes Run coordinator, events team, etc
